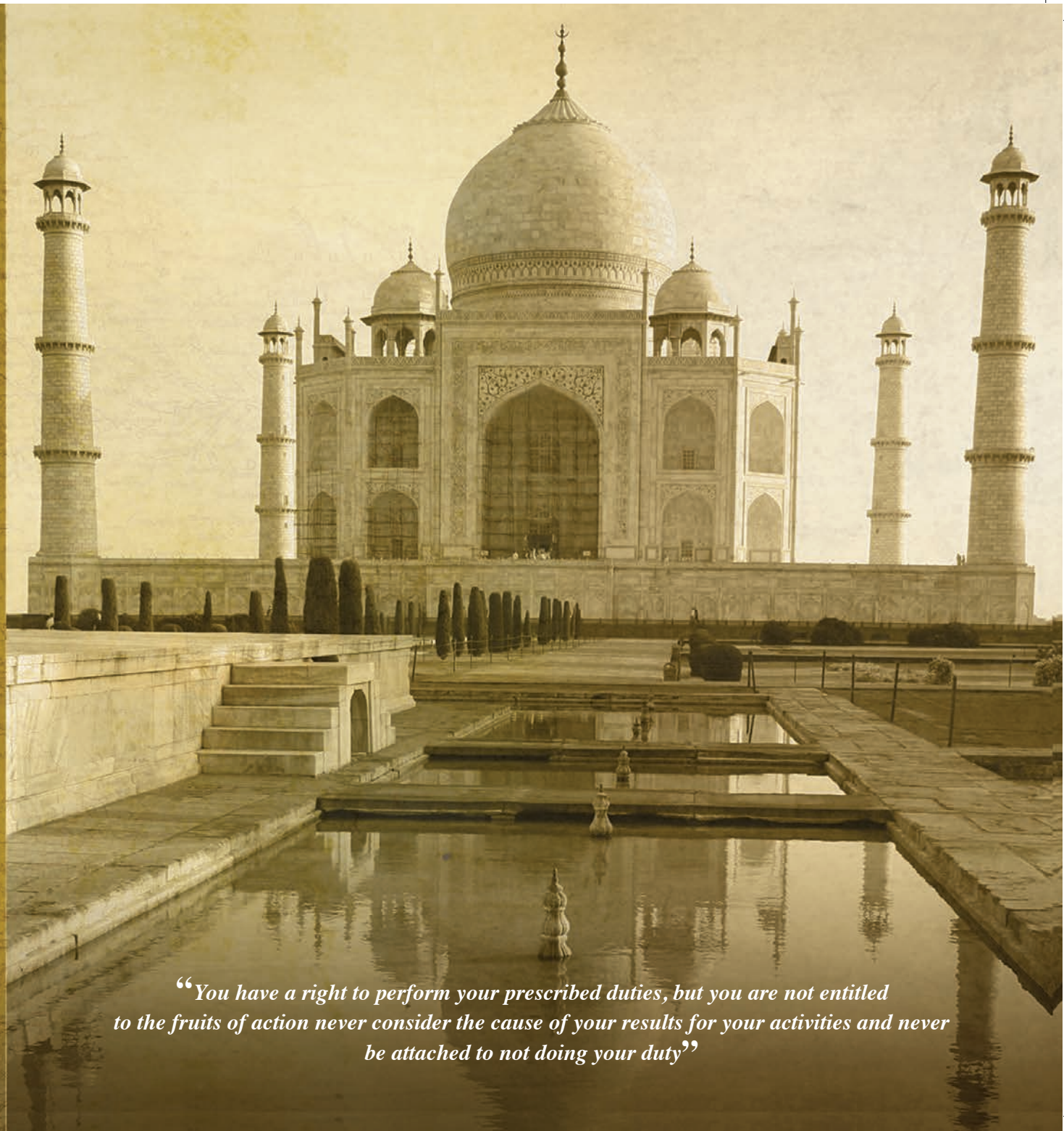

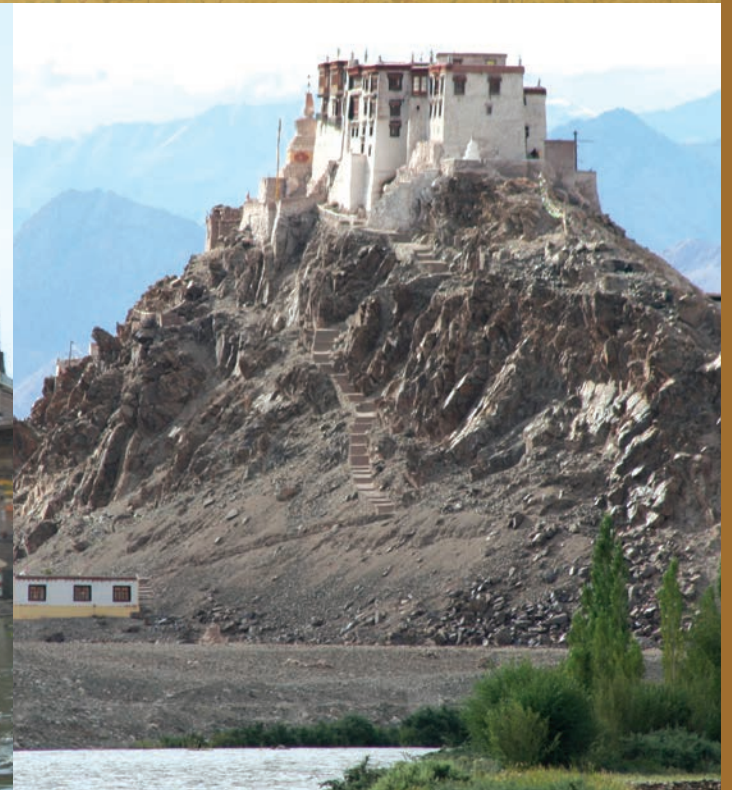

Delhi - Jaipur - Agra

Day 01 : Delhi

Arrive Delhi International airport. Overnight in Delhi.

Day 02 : Delhi

After Breakfast proceed on a tour of New Delhi and Old Delhi, including the Red Fort and the Jama Masjid. The capital designed by Lutyens and characterized by wide, tree-lined avenues and magnificent colonial buildings. Drive past India Gate, the President's Palace and visit the Qutub Minar. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Delhi.

Day 03 : Delhi – Agra

After Breakfast leave for Agra. On arrival in Agra, check into your Hotel. In the evening, a half day tour of Agra city takes you on a visit to the Taj Mahal - one of the seven wonders of the world and the Agra Fort, a magnificent citadel with exquisite marble palaces, ornate, alcoves and terrace pavilions. 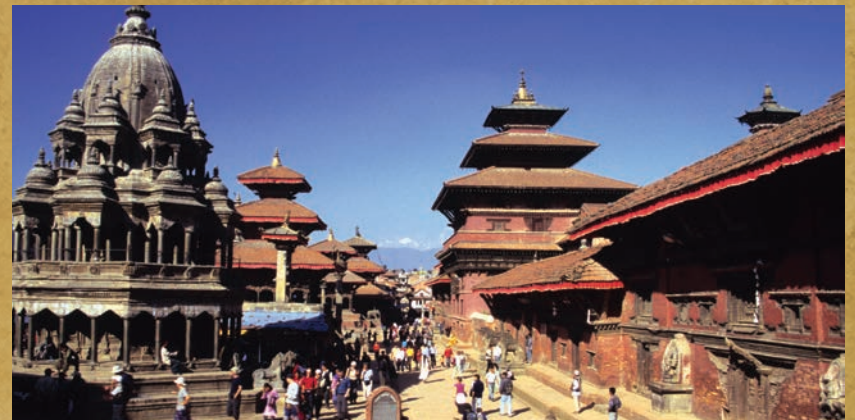

After Breakfast visit Golden Temple and continue drive to Dharmshala. P M visit the Monastery. Night at the Hotel.

Day 04: Dharamshala – Manali

After Breakfast leave for Manali , enroute visit Triloknath Temple. Check into your Hotel. P M for leisure activites. Night at the Hotel.

Day 05: Manali

After Breakfast, A M visit Pagoda Temple of Hadimba Devi and Old Manali to see the Manu Temple. Afternoon visit to the Vaishisht Hot Sulphur Spring Bath. Night at the Hotel.

Day 06: Manali – Jispa

After Breakfast leave for Jispa. Enroute visit to Keylong local bazaar and continue drive to Jispa. Night at the Hotel.

Day 07: Jispa – Sarchu

After Breakfast leave for Sarchu. Enroute visit to Dalai lama Monastery. Night in Tents.

Day 08: Sarchu – Leh

After Breakfast leave for Leh and chance to see tiny colonies of Marmots & Yaks. Night at the Hotel.

Day 09: Leh – Alchi – Leh

After Breakfast, full day excursion to Basgo Fort and Alchi Monastery. In the evening return back to Leh. Night at the Hotel.

Day 10: Leh

After Breakfast, half day tour of Spituk and Phyang Monastery. Afternoon visit King's Palace, Leh Mosque, Leh Gompa and Shankar Gompa. Night at the Hotel.

Day 11: Leh

After Breakfast, full day to visit Thiskey Monastery to see praying ceremony and visit one of the biggest Monastery of Leh "Hemis". On the way back visit Shey palace. Night at the Hotel.

Day 12: Leh – Delhi

After Breakfast transfer to the Airport for Flight to Delhi. Arrival at Delhi Airport. Half day free for city tour and shopping.

Day 13: Delhi

Transfer to the Airport for flight to Home destination.

Day 01: Delhi

Arrive Delhi. Transfer to Hotel for overnight.

Day 02: Delhi

After Breakfast, A M visit new Delhi, where you shall visit the Humayun's Tomb, The Parliament Buildings, India Gate and Qutub Minar. P M visit Old Delhi. Here you shall visit The Jama Masjid Mosque, the Red Fort, Streets of Chandani Chowk and Raj Ghat. Night at the Hotel.

Day 03: Delhi – Shimla

After Breakfast, A M leave for Shimla. On arrival check in at Hotel. Shimla was the British capital during the British rule. P M walk through the City Mall along the ridge, which leads to the Christ Church in the city center, passing through some old British Buildings. Night at the Hotel

Day 04: Shimla – Manali

After Breakfast, A M leave for Manali. On arrival check in at Hotel. P M walk through the old town of Manali. Night at the Hotel.

Day 05: Manali

After Breakfast, A M visit Pagoda Temple of Hadimba Devi and Old Manali to see the Manu Temple. Afternoon visit to the Vaishisht hot sulphur spring bath. Night at the Hotel.

Day 06: Manali – Keylong

After Breakfast, A M leave for Keylong, the capital city of Lahaul. The road continues through the green fields and along the Chandra River, which meets the Bhaga River at the Tandi village. From here the river is called the Chandra Bhaga (Chenab).

Enroute you might visit some gaddies with some herds of sheep. On arrival check in at Hotel.

Day 07: Keylong

After Breakfast, A M visit the Khardong monastery, formerly the capital of Lahaul, the only Nunnery in Lahaul Valley. PM visit the Sha-Shur Monastery, which is in the opposite direction of the Khardong. It is a small Monastery and the way through the villages is very interesting. Night at the Hotel.

Day 08: Keylong – Sarchu

After Breakfast, A M leave for Sarchu, the road climbs to Patseo and goes over Baralachha Pass (4,880 mts) at the cross road of Lahaul, Zaskar, Spiti and Ladakh before dropping to Sarchu. Night at the Hotel.

Day 09: Sarchu – Leh

After Breakfast, A M leave for Leh, enroute crossing two passes Nakali la approx 4900 mts and Lachalung la approx 5350 mts, one of the highest Motorable Pass in the world. On arrival at Leh check in a Hotel. P M short walk through the market place. Night at the Hotel.

Day 10: Leh

After Breakfast, A M full day excursion to visit Thiksey Monastery for which one should leave early morning so as to see the early morning prayers being performed. The most impressive of them all for its images, Stupas and Exquisite wall paintings. It also houses a two-storeyed statue of Buddha. Continue to visit one of the biggest Monasteries in Leh, known as "Hemis".



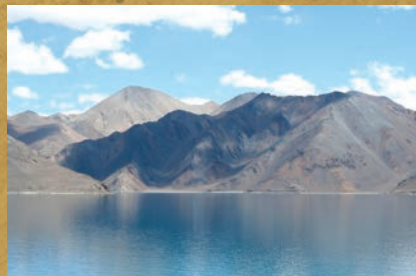

The biggest and richest of them all is well known for its festival in summer. Night at the Hotel.

Day 11: Leh

After Breakfast, A M half day tour of Spituk and Phyang Monastery. Afternoon visit King's Palace, Leh Mosque, Leh Gompa and Shankar Gompa. It has innumerable statues of pure gold and number of paintings. Night at the Hotel.

Day 12: Leh

After Breakfast, full day excursion to Basgo Fort and Alchi Gompa, dating a thousand years back. One of the walls feature thousands of miniature-sized images of clay and painted brightly are its focal attraction. It

is also the only monastery in Ladakh on flat ground. Night at the Hotel.

Day 13: Leh

Valley of Flowers



Gangharia

The valley of flowers was discovered accidentally by an explorer and mountaineer, Frank Smith. Surrounded by the river Pushpavati and small streams, at an altitude ranging between

3658 to 3962 mts. The Valley is 10 kms. long and 2 kms. wide. The Valley remains snow covered from November to May, but in the month of June, when the snow melts, the valley blooms with colours hidden in the petals of rare species of Flowers and spreads as the carpet of Flowers woven by the Mother Nature. Apart from flowering plants, wild Animals and Birds enhance the beauty of this natural flowering valley. Night at the Hotel.



Hemkund Saheb

Situated at the height of 4329 mts. near the Valley of Flowers, is the holy Hemkund Lokpal Lake. Though the climb is steep and tiring, it provides scenic beauty and majestic view of crystal clear lake surrounded by seven snow clad peaks of the Mighty Himalayas. According to Holy Granth Saheb, the 10th Guru of Sikh Faith, Guru Gobind Singh mediated on the banks of this lake in his earlier births. This place is also associated with Laxman, the younger brother of Rama. It is believed that Laxman mediated by the lake and regained his health after being severely wounded by Megnath, son of the Demon Ravan, during the battle. There is Lakshman Temple, built on the bank of the Lake.

Mostly Lata Kharak is famous for Nanda Peaks such as Ronthi & Nanda Ghunti, Bethar Toli, Nanda Khat & many other Nanda Peaks, these all Peaks are seen so nearly by Lata Kharak as one can imagine catching them. Lata village, Tapovan, Dhak & Bhavisya Badri are easily seen from here. Zandhidhaar 3928m – Its 4 km steep climb for Zandhidhaar from Lata Kharak but everything is forgotten when Donagri, Dronagri & Trishul Peak comes on the way. One has to make many ascents and descents to reach Zandhidhaar.

After Breakfast leave for Snertse. Enroute steep and difficult climb to Purfila steep descent will reach Oma - Chu River. Night in Tents.

Day 09: Snertse – Hanumala – Lingshad

After Breakfast for Lingshad enroute visit Hanumala and arrive at Lingshad. Night in Tents.

Bhutan

Day 10: Lingshad – Foot of Singela

After Breakfast leave for Foot of Singela. Enroute see the Nierang Valley, after passing the village of Gongma and Skiumpata a steep ascent to Kubala. Arrive Foot of Singela. Night in Tents.

Day 11: Foot of Singela – Singela – Photoksar

After Breakfast leave for Photoskar. Enroute pass a short desert, this opens in a broad valley. Night in Tents.

Day 12: Photoksa – Sirsila – Hanupatta

After Breakfast leave for Hanupatta. Enroute visit Sirsila, last ascent is steep. After passing Stone Valley arrive at camp site little before Hanupatta. Night in Tents.

Day 13: Hanupatta – Wanla – Shilla

After Breakfast leave for Wanla/Shilla continue descent across a junction of the Rivers Chorten and fluttering flags on a flat land. Arrive at Shilla. Night in Tents.

Day 14: Wanla – Shilla – Lamayuru

After Breakfast leave for Lamayuru. Enroute visit a narrow and dry reach at Prinkitila. Visit the Monastery. Night in Tents.

Day 15: Lamayuru – Leh

After Breakfast leave for leh. On the way visit Alchi and Likir Monastery. Night at the Hotel.

Day 16: Leh – Delhi

After Breakfast transfer to the Airport to Flight for Delhi. Arrival at Delhi Airport. Half day free for city Tour.

Day 17: Delhi

Transfer to the Airport for flight to connect flight for Home destination.

Day 01 : Delhi

Upon arrival meeting at Delhi Airport. Check into Hotel for overnight.

Day 02: Delhi

After Breakfast visit Old Delhi's Jama Masjid, Red Fort and Chandni Chowk. P M visit New Delhi's Humayun's Tomb, India Gate, Parliament Buildings and Qutub Minar. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 03: Flight Delhi / Paro

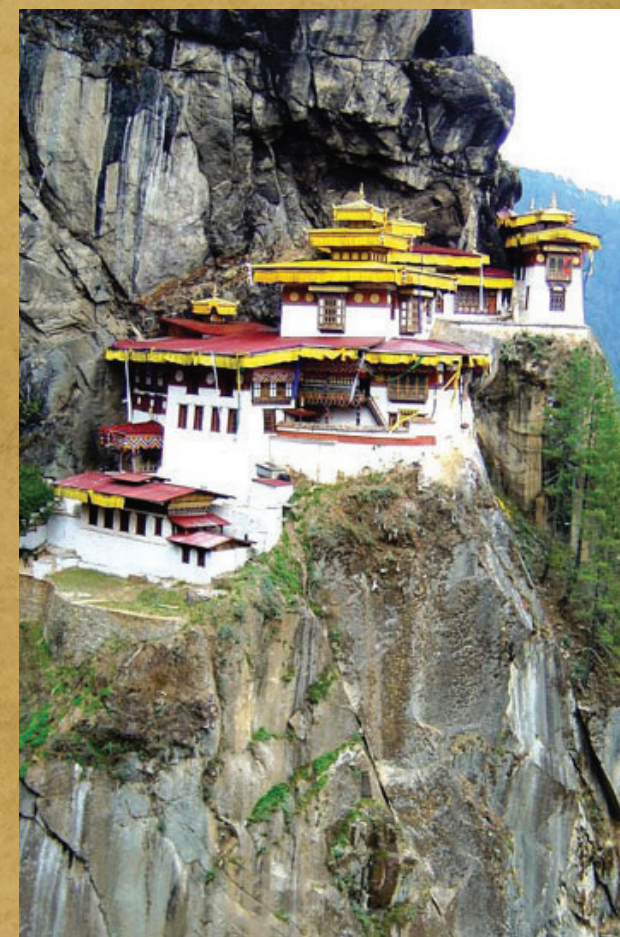
After Breakfast flight for Bhutan. Meeting & assistance on arrival and transfer to the hotel. Evening take a stroll around Paro market and town. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 04: Paro

After Breakfast we will take a hike to TAKTSANG (Tiger's Nest). It is about 3 hrs walk uphill to reach the TAKTSANG MONASTERY. Return downhill on foot. In the evening stroll in the Paro Valley. Overnight at the hotel. Taktsang Monastery also called Tiger Nest is situated on a nearly vertical cliff at 3000m altitude north of Paro in Bhutan. A number of famous masters have meditated in caves near the current monastery: Guru Rinpoche in his manifestation of Dorje Drollö meditated on the Kagyé cycle. After him, many great masters followed; among them were Milarepa, Padampa Sangye, Machik Lapdrön and Thangtong Gyalpo. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 05: Paro – Thimphu

After Breakfast drive to Thimphu en route visit Simtokha Dzong, the oldest fortress of the Kingdom which now houses the School for religious and cultural studies. Afternoon free for shopping and leisure. Overnight at the Hotel.



Day 06: Thimphu

After Breakfast enjoy the full day sightseeing of Thimphu, visiting the National Library (ancient Buddhist manuscripts); School of Art and Crafts (Thangka painting and other traditional arts); Textile & Folk Heritage Museum; and a scenic drive above the valley to see the small Takin zoo. (National animal of Bhutan. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 07: Thimphu – Punakha

After Breakfast drive to Punakha taking a short stop at Dochula pass (3,080m) that heralds the most enchanting views of Bhutan. Afternoon visit Punakha Dzong and Khamsum Yulley Namgyal Chorten (chorten = stupa). Evening free in fascinating Punakha valley. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 08: Punakha – Paro

After Breakfast transfer to Paro. Afternoon visit to Paro market and a traditional farm house. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 09: Paro

After Breakfast drive to Drukgyel Dzong ruins (Monastery Fortress) that once was a strategic post to with hold invading Tibetan forces from the north; visit the famous Kyichu Lhakhang - one of 108 sacred Lhakhangs built by the Buddhist King Srongtsen Gomba of Tibet. Visit the

district Dzong called Rinpung Dzong - Fortress of a Mountain of Jewels, which is now the seat of administration and an institute to the monks. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 10: Paro – Delhi

After Breakfast transfer to the airport for flight to Delhi. Upon arrival meeting at Delhi Airport and last minute shopping for Souvenirs.

Day 11: Delhi

Leave for Airport for onwards flight.
